These are direct financial contributions, known as grants, that are awarded to third-party beneficiaries (e.g., research organisations, public entities, non-governmental organisations, and private companies) to engage in activities that serve EU policies.

- Themes, priorities, activities to be funded and expected impact
- Available budget
- Timetable and deadlines
- Admissibility and eligibility conditions

- Legal and financial set-up of the Grant Agreements

AGA – Annotated Grant Agreement

- Always refer to the latest version of the AGA, and check the history of changes to see the updates

Travel and subsistence



Article 6.2 and Annex 2a

- Costs related to travel, accommodation and subsistence for personnel, for invited experts and speakers, etc. (except for the subcontractors)
- Costs must be declared using the **unit cost fixed by [Decision C\(2021\)35](#) and set out in [Annex 2a](#)**
If a particular instance of travel, accommodation or subsistence in the action is not covered by one of the unit costs mentioned in the Decision C(2021)35, **actual costs** may be used.


Which unit cost?

If the opening date of the call is before 31 July 2024: Decision C(2021)35 as amended by C(2023)4928

If the opening date of the call is after 31 July 2024: Decision C(2021)35 as amended by C(2024)5405

- **Travel unit costs** : depend on the distance between the place of departure and place of arrival.
All unit costs cover a return trip. Calculation of the distance : 1-way distance between the points.
Distance must be measured using the [distance calculators](#).
